- Cause a road accident and be badly injured or even killed;
- Be stolen by pet thieves;
- Get lost and be unable to return home safely

Moreover, all dog-catchers are instructed to catch all dogs roaming freely in the streets, licensed or not, collared or not

If you want your dog to go out for its daily toilet routine, then take it for a walk on a leash. You will benefit from the exercise; your dog will love the companionship of a daily walk with its master!
