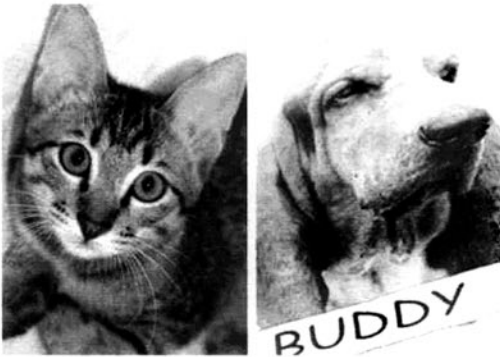




## FOSTER HOMES WANTED!

- Do you love animals but don't have the time to adopt one?
- Do you have short periods in your timetable where you are able to foster a companion animal? 1 week, 2 weeks, 3 weeks or 1 month.

...Consider SPCA'S Foster Programme.



Because SPCA has an open door policy and accepts all animals surrendered to us, you can imagine the numbers we receive monthly— 1,200 dogs, pups, cats and kittens! 90% are humanely euthanized because of lack of space... but this is NOT the long-term answer. SPCA operates a low-cost SPAY/NEUTER CLINIC and pre-sterilizes all adopted animals but the tide of surrenders continue. So... instead of putting them down... we look for FOSTER HOMES to care for young and orphaned, sick or injured pups, kittens, dogs and cats. Once they are well, we will look for good homes for them.

### Tips on fostering pups & kittens

- Pups and kittens need 3 – 4 meals a day
- They need a lot of tender loving care
- Being young, like children, they are susceptible to kennel cough, cold, diarrhoea (all non-fatal) or distemper and enteroviral infection (fatal)
- Keep them warm and sheltered in their cages
- Once vaccinated, do not bathe them for 10 days.
- Do not get upset if they do not make it. You have tried your best.
